Sign of Toxicity

Fever, Collapse, Seizures,
Drooling, Lethargy, Vomiting,
Tremors, Diarrhea, Weakness,
Restlessness, Hyperactivity,
Stomach Bloat, Muscle
twitching, Excessive panting,
Excessive urination

Do's & Don't for a Healthy Cat

1. Never declaw your cat
2. Never trim or cut their whiskers
3. Never pull their tail
4. Never push or throw them to teach
5. Never overfeed them
6. Don't forget to spay or neuter them
7. Never forget their vet visits
8. Don't forget window exposure to outside
9. Never let or leave your cat outside
10. Never expose your cat to secondhand smoke
11. Never ignore your cats vomiting
12. Never let them play with yarn or string
13. Make sure to scoop your cats litter box at least once daily and change out once a week
14. Don't ignore your cat's change in body language
15. Don't ignore their change in bathroom habits
16. Unless vet recommended, don't shave your cat
17. Don't give your cat human or dog medications
18. Don't be too loud around your cat
19. Don't neglect to groom your cat
20. Don't forget to give fresh water daily
21. Don't forget to give plenty of love and attention to your cat
